Registration

Program Cancellation

Cardel Rec South programs are subject to being combined and/or cancelled if registration does not meet minimum participant requirements. Every effort will be made to transfer affected registrants to a suitable alternate program. If a class is cancelled, a credit will be applied to your account, or a refund will be processed if requested.

Program Withdrawal

Fourteen days or more prior to the start of a program - a full refund will be processed.

Seven to fourteen days prior to start of a camp - withdrawal requests will be processed minus a \$10.00 cancellation/withdrawal fee per activity, with the program fee applied as a credit to your account.

Less than seven days before the start of or after a program start date - withdrawals will be subject to a full cost of a program. No refunds or withdrawals will be processed unless accompanied by a doctor's note. This must be approved by the Program Coordinator.

Medical withdrawal - a doctor's note must be provided within two weeks of request.

Subsidy

The City of Calgary Fee Assistance Program will only be available to use on Cardel Rec South programs. They cannot be used for third-party programs such as Engineering for Kids, Little Medical School, Sportball and Young Rembrandts.













